

Competition 3.1: Eruptions and transformations

Write a poem or short story using volcanic themes for inspiration. Try your hand at a sonnet (look at the 'rules' about structure and rhyme schemes [here](#)), a [haiku](#), or make up your own form (see [Brian Bilston](#) for inspiration: could you write a poem in the shape of a volcano?) You may even want to turn your poem into a song.

Your submission should showcase your creative process and can be in the form of written text, audio, video or visual art.

How to enter

1. Complete your competition entry and make sure it follows the guidelines listed below

Terms & Conditions

1. You must complete the [Competition Cover Sheet](#) and submit it along with your entry to inspire@sjc.ox.ac.uk before the closing date. If we do not receive a completed cover sheet with your entry, we will NOT be able to consider the entry.
2. The competition closes at **5pm on Monday 23 March 2020**. Once you submit your entry you will receive an automated confirmation that your entry has been submitted.
3. The work you submit must be entirely your own. Written submissions may not exceed 500 words; if you submit work that is longer than 500 words, only the first 500 words will be considered. Audio or video submissions may not exceed 2 minutes in length; if you submit work that is longer than 2 minutes, only the first 2 minutes will be considered.
4. Competition winners will be contacted via email about a week after the competition's closing date. The following prizes will be awarded:
 - a. 1st place: £20 Amazon gift voucher, entry listed on Inspire Digital
 - b. 2nd place: £10 Amazon gift voucher, entry listed on Inspire Digital
 - c. Top 10 entries: entry listed on Inspire Digital
