

### **Competition 3: Volcanoes in art**

Create a piece of visual art (a drawing, painting, model or sculpture) which conveys an emotional response to a volcano. You may consider: a dormant or active volcano, a landscape (scenery) or portrait (people) composition, and may use traditional or modern artforms, including digital. You should include a short explanation of your work of no more than 100 words.
