



1. **Open/Model Preferences icon:** Opens a menu with open/save/import/export and geolocation tools.
2. **Model name:** Click Untitled to save your model to Trimble Connect.
3. **Undo and redo** tools
4. **Toolbar:** This toolbar contains the tools you need to create 3D models. For the most part, these tools work just like their counterparts in the desktop version of SketchUp. In SketchUp for Web, some tools have a flyout menu that holds additional tools.

Top to bottom:

- Search tool
- Select
- Eraser
- Fill
- Line
- Arc
- Polygon
- Push/pull
- Outer shell tools (solids)
- Rotate
- Tape measure
- Walk
- Orbit and view (inc zoom)

5. **Status bar:** From left to right: a link to the Help Center, a language menu, tips and options for the selected tool, and the Measurements box for modelling accurately.
6. **Panels:** Click these icons to access panels for entity info, outline, the Instructor, 3D warehouse, components, materials, styles, tags, layers, views, display, model info, and solid inspector (for 3D printing).
